We certainly understand if you need to bring your children with you when you drop off your items. For their safety, please be sure they stay with you at all times. Thanks!

Donating ALL of your unsold items? Please bring your self-addressed, stamped envelope. We will help you unload your items, give you your shopping pass—and you are done!

ALL OTHER CONSIGNORS

Please remember to bring a standard sized rectangular laundry basket or a bin with your ID # clearly (boldly) visible on one end. You will leave this for us to use, and it will be returned to you at pick up at the end of the sale. If you are consigning more than 100 items, please bring a second laundry basket or bin.

- 1-Please observe all loading zones and church parking restrictions and signs.
- 2-Bring completely prepared items with all clothing tagged, hung with hanger facing to the left, and sorted by size and gender.
- 3-We will help you unload your large items first*. While a worker begins checking them, we will help unload the rest of your items, and accept take your self-addressed envelope. * *Because we do not have available storage for unacceptable large items, you will need to wait until these are checked to be sure they are being included in the sale. We will work as quickly as possible. We LOVE including the large items, and shoppers buy them, so bring all you have!!*
- 4- Please bring with you any tools that are needed for items requiring assembly. While your other large items are being checked, you may be asked to do the assembly. When this is done and your large items are checked, you will be given your shopping pass, and you are free to go! We will take care of getting your clothing and other items inside.
- 5- Remember to leave UNSEALED any bagged infant items (shoes, diapers, blankets, crib sheets, etc) and all smaller accessories so they can be checked. Please leave in your bin a roll of clear packing tape for us to seal the bags after contents are inspected. We will return any unused tape to you!

6-All items will be inspected for quality, season, and proper tagging and preparation. We try to be very thorough, but we could miss things. If this occurs, we reserve the right to pull things found during the sale that are not up to standard. These will be put with your items for pick up or donation.

7- NOTE: If, after drop off, we find any items that are on the current recall list, they will be pulled, even if they have gone through the initial check in. Your signed contract is binding and states that you have checked the federal list and are complying with the guidelines for acceptable items.

8- Please be sure to get your shopping pass—and use it! There will be great inventory, and we want to support each other!!

9-THANK YOU For being patient with us as we implement this new drop procedure. We hope it will be much better for all of us. The curbside drop off should also help with our COVID compliance.
